With its wood flooring, wood-paneled walls, exposed beams, three stone hearth fireplaces and natural pine tables, the Clerks' Quarters is perfect for rustic-themed events.

The rustic feel continues outside, with the views of the surrounding wood buildings of the 1846 Fur Trading Fort and outdoor fire pit. The Fort courtyard is included with Clerks' Quarters bookings, making the Quarters a very private and exclusive venue.

THE HISTORY

During the 1840s, the Clerks' Quarters was a place that Hudson Bay Company's mostly unmarried single men and gentlemen visitors slept (on the second floor garrett). The Quarters also included a great hall, the chief trader's office and quarters, a kitchen and the cook's quarters.
