The perfect venue for intimate ceremonies, St. Anthony's Church is a non-ordained facility that can host secular and non-secular ceremonies of any denomination.

Situated on 1905 street and richly decorated with antiques, this original church is lovely for smaller ceremonies any time of year. Attached to the chapel is an adorable little classroom with a separate entrance which serves nicely as a green room for any bridal party.

THE HISTORY

St. Anthony's Church was built in 1894 for the Catholic residents of South Edmonton (today's Strathcona). Almost immediately after its completion, members of the congregation organized the St. Anthony Roman Catholic School District. The chapel was also used as a school until 1901, when the new classroom addition was added.
