This charming church is a non-ordained facility that can host secular and non-secular ceremonies of any denomination. The white and grey trimmed church is surrounded by mature trees and green space — a perfect backdrop for photos. Inside, the hardwood floors and wood-paneled walls and ceiling are accompanied with character pieces, such as a pot-belly stove, arched windows and detailed lectern. Natural light pours in through the north, south and east windows and clear glass filament bulbs help add any extra needed light to illuminate the beautiful church.

THE HISTORY

St. Michael's All Angels Church was built in 1910 in the village of North Edmonton (127 Avenue and 69 Street). It remained active until 1972, when the City of Edmonton intended to develop the church land. It was moved to Fort Edmonton Park and reconsecrated in 1974. The church is the original with a few renovations.
